# LETTER FROM THE CEO



Pentecost wasn't just the launch of the church. It was the decentralization of the flame.

The Spirit didn't stay in one place. He empowered ordinary people and told them to take it home. And when they did, the fire spread.

That's what we saw in 2024.

Not just big numbers, but big handoffs. The kind where one person gets lit up by the Gospel and turns around to light up five more. A father risks everything to pray for his son. A former witchdoctor opens his home. Churches started multiplying deep in the forest before any outsider ever showed up because the Word got there first.

That's how you know it's a movement. It doesn't run on programs or big personalities. It spreads when regular people hear the Word, do what it says, and help others do the same. That kind of obedience moves through natural networks—house to house, village to village—without anyone needing to manage it.

It's fueled by prayer, rooted in Scripture, and passed from one person to the next, often by people you'll never meet this side of eternity.

I believe we're living in a reawakening. God is calling His people back to the basics:

- Don't just shine. Start something.
- Don't just lead. Make disciples who make more disciples.
- Don't just go. Hand it off so it keeps going without you.

This is how the Kingdom moves. One step of obedience at a time. One life passing it to the next.

# THE FATHER WHO DARED TO ASK

## FRANCOPHONE CENTRAL AFRICA

In a remote village in Cameroon, fear ruled the atmosphere. Community leaders had made it clear: anyone who abandoned ancestral traditions wouldn't survive the night. But one father couldn't ignore the question burning in his heart—Can Jesus heal my son?

He approached J.B., a New Generations movement catalyst who had arrived quietly, carrying only an audio player with Scripture in the local language.

J.B. didn't hesitate. He and the father prayed under lantern light, crying out to Jesus. And by morning, the boy was healed.

Fear gave way to faith. The father—once silent—began telling everyone what Jesus had done! He started Discovery Bible Studies in his home. Neighbors who used to avoid any talk of Jesus began to come. And soon, courage began to spread faster than fear.

Not far away, a witchdoctor's wife found a similar courage. She had been secretly listening to Scripture on an audio player. When her husband found it, she ran in fear. But he—curious—pressed play. Night after night, he listened. Eventually, he invited others. And then he made a decision that changed everything: he gave his life to Jesus.

Now he leads his own gatherings. A man who once trafficked in darkness now helps others walk in truth. And in both places, the Gospel continues to spread—one conversation, one gathering, one act of courage at a time.



## SIX GENERATIONS SPARKED IN SIX MONTHS

### CENTRAL AFRICAN REPUBLIC

They live deep in the forest, far from cities, the internet, or roads. Many belong to nomadic Pygmy tribes along the border of Congo and the Central African Republic—communities that have historically been overlooked or forgotten. But God hasn't forgotten them.

In 2024, our teams began equipping local leaders to carry audio Bibles into the forest—small, solar-powered devices loaded with Scripture in the heart languages of these communities. And something remarkable happened.

Before a single church planter could arrive in person, Discovery Bible Studies began forming. One group turned into three. Then five. Then more.

Within just six months, six generations of churches had formed. From one person to another, from one gathering to the next, the Gospel traveled faster than we ever could—because the Word got there first.

This is what it means to ignite a movement. It doesn't require buildings or budgets. Just truth, trust, and tools that work in the hardest places.





# MEDIA MULTIPLIERS

HOW ONE CLICK CAN SPARK A MOVEMENT

He wasn't looking for Jesus. He was just scrolling Facebook in Afghanistan. But that's where he saw it—a short video ad, just a few lines of text, inviting people to hear stories of hope. He clicked. Then he listened. Then he responded.

Today, that man has helped start over 100 Discovery Bible Study groups and seen hundreds come to faith. And it all started with a click!

This is the power of Media Multipliers—New Generations' digital outreach strategy launched in 2024. By using targeted ads in spiritually resistant regions, our teams are identifying two key kinds of people:

**Persons of Peace** – spiritually open individuals who are ready to gather others

**Catalytic Leaders** – high-capacity believers who multiply what they receive

Digital outreach doesn't replace face-to-face presence. It opens doors to conversations that can become face-to-face, while also connecting with people in places our teams can't physically reach. And in some places, a single \$20 ad gives more than 7,000 people the opportunity to hear the Gospel—often in regions where it's never been heard before.

That's the power of Media Multipliers. They open doors in hard-to-reach places and start conversations that can lead to movements!

## ENDING SCRIPTURE POVERTY

HEARING GOD'S WORD IN THEIR OWN LANGUAGE

Through our Ending Scripture Poverty initiative, local teams are working to expand access to the Word of God in a language and format people can truly engage with. For many, especially in oral-preferred cultures, that means audio. One example comes from a crowded market in Cameroon.

A woman who had never owned a Bible, and couldn't have read one if she did, heard something entirely new: Scripture in her "heart" language. Spoken aloud. Not by a preacher. Not as a sermon. Just the voice of Jesus, telling stories that felt like they were meant for her.

She kept listening. Then others began to listen with her. A Discovery Bible Study formed. That group multiplied. And today, a growing movement traces back to one woman... and an audio player!

This is what happens when people hear God speak in a voice they understand.

It's why we're committed to Ending Scripture Poverty—so that people in the most remote and overlooked places can hear God's Word in a way they can take to heart. For many, especially in oral cultures, that means hearing it spoken aloud—just like the woman in the Cameroon market that day.

# THIS IS HOW MOVEMENTS MULTIPLY

A Disciple Making Movement happens when disciples make disciples and churches plant churches—again and again and again. We define a movement as at least 100 new churches that have multiplied to the fourth generation or beyond.

It's important to know that movements don't begin with mass events or programs. They begin the way Jesus began—with prayer, presence, and people.

This simple cycle shows how disciples are made, churches are formed, and new generations are launched. At the center is the Father's heart because His love is the fuel behind it all.

Let's unpack each component to show how they work together to set in motion a chain-reaction of Kingdom impact.



## PRAY

Because movements don't begin with activity, they begin with intercession.

Before a disciple-maker enters a new village, before a conversation begins, someone is on their knees—asking God to open hearts, direct steps, and prepare the way. Prayer is the starting point because it re-centers us around the real leader: the Holy Spirit.

*"We don't go until we've prayed. Because until we pray, we don't know where God is already at work."* —Field Leader, West Africa

## ENGAGE

Because after prayer comes presence.

Engagement isn't loud or flashy—it's local, personal, and often simple. A soccer ball. A shared meal. A neighbor who keeps showing up. These small acts build trust—and trust opens the door for deeper conversations.

*"They weren't interested in church—but they were interested in soccer. And that's where we started."* —Field Team Leader, West Africa



## FIND

Because trust opens hearts, and curiosity opens conversations.

As relationships deepen, disciple-makers listen for signs of spiritual hunger. Questions begin to surface. Stories resonate more deeply. This is the moment to recognize a "Person of Peace"—someone who is spiritually curious, and who has community influence and may open the door to others.

*"We thought no one was listening. But God had already prepared his heart—we just didn't know it yet."* —Local leader, Burkina Faso



## DISCOVER

Because when it's personal, it's powerful.

When someone opens the Bible—whether on a printed page or through an audio player in their language—they're not just learning about God. They're discovering who He is for themselves. Through simple, obedient engagement with Scripture, lives begin to shift, and often, new spiritual communities are born.

## GATHER

Because disciples aren't meant to walk alone.

As new believers grow in their faith, they begin to gather—sometimes under trees, in alleyways, or in living rooms—to pray, worship, and obey

what they've discovered in Scripture. These simple gatherings become churches: spiritual families centered on Jesus, shaped by His Word, and committed to making more disciples.

## REPLICATE

Because the Gospel must get to everyone, everywhere.

In healthy movements, churches don't just grow—they replicate. New believers become disciple-makers. New churches plant more churches. And the cycle continues, fueled by obedience, simplicity, and the power of the Holy Spirit.

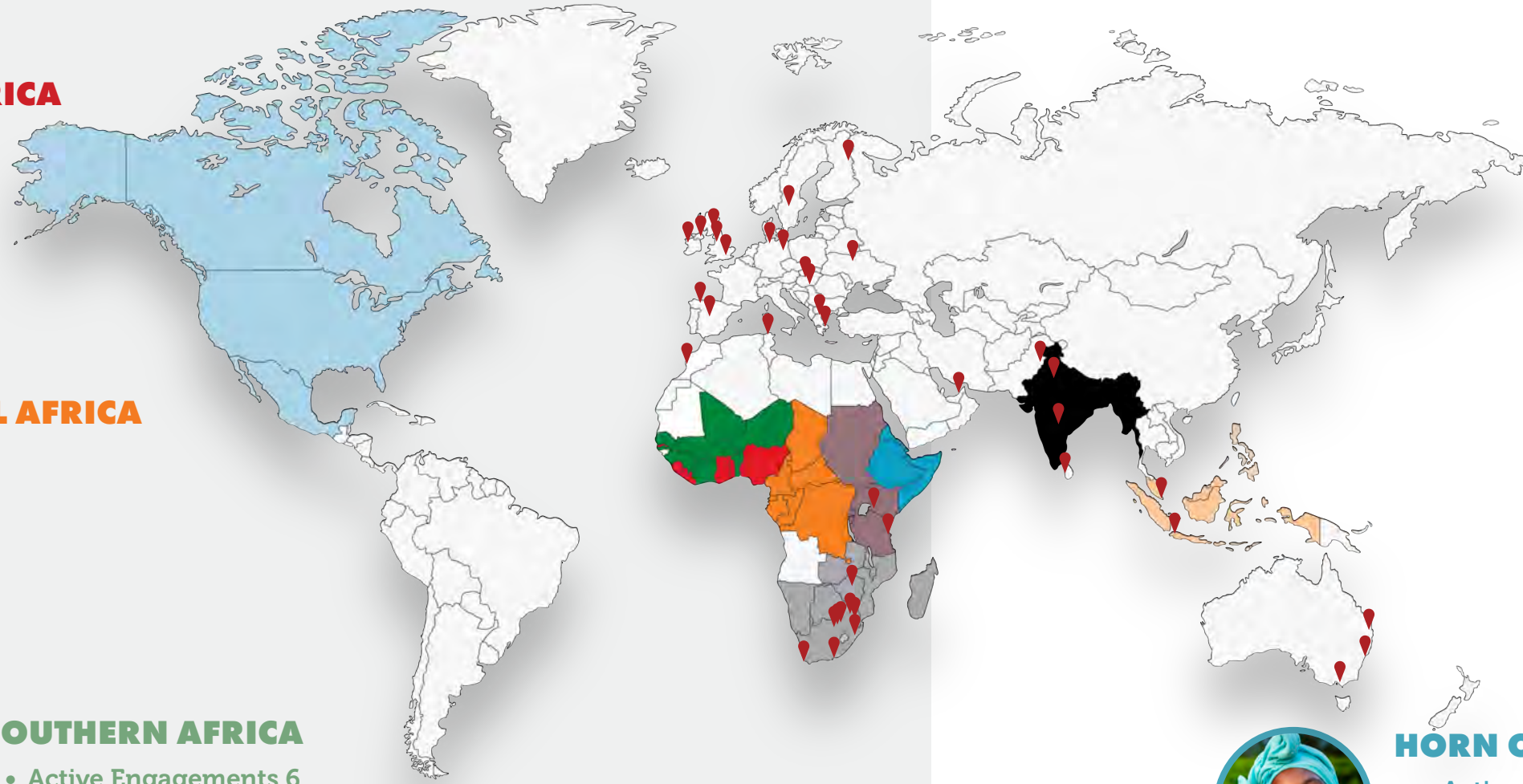

## URBAN CENTERS

As the world rapidly urbanizes, more people than ever are moving into cities—bringing with them diverse cultures, beliefs, and needs. Urban centers have become the new frontier of missions.

In addition to 1,012 people group engagements, we are working in 56 key cities around the world—reaching deeply marginalized and mobile populations such as refugees, street kids, gang members, slum dwellers, and prisoners. # WHEN PRAYER IS THE STRATEGY, MOVEMENTS MULTIPLY

Some meet at midnight. Others gather at dawn. Some fast for days. Others kneel in the dirt. But across the globe, more than 100,000 intercessors are carrying this work—not with microphones or money, but with prayer.

They don't always see the outcome. But the outcome always starts with them.

In northern India, believers trek through mountain villages, praying over every home. In West Africa, teams meet through the night to pray for neighbors gripped by fear. In Myanmar, prayer happens in silence—lips barely moving, hearts fully engaged.

This is the unseen backbone of every movement.

We often say the Gospel advances through people—but it starts with prayer. Before there's a disciple, there's an intercessor. Before there's multiplication, there's surrender. That's why New Generations equips and supports local prayer leaders in every region where we work.

As Shodankeh Johnson, one of our movement leaders, puts it: "Prayer isn't just something we do. It's our way of life."



## OUR BROTHERS AND SISTERS COUNTED THE COST—AND SAID 'YES' ANYWAY

In many of the places where Disciple Making Movements are multiplying, following Jesus isn't just unpopular—it's dangerous.

A father in Cameroon risks his life to pray in the open. A woman in Myanmar listens to Scripture in secret. A new believer in South Asia is baptized in the middle of the night, far from the eyes of neighbors who might report them.

This isn't history. It's now.

But what's remarkable is not just their courage—it's the joy that follows. Because when the Gospel breaks through, even in the face of pressure and persecution, the story doesn't end in suffering. It ends in kingdom advance.

The early church understood this. So do these believers. They've counted the cost—and said "yes" anyway.

## BECAUSE YOU SENT THE WORD

### WEST AFRICA

He was a traditional voodoo priest who was deeply feared and deeply respected. People in his village came to him for healing, for answers, for protection. He wore charms, performed rituals, and called on the spirits of his ancestors. But one day, his daughter came home talking about something he couldn't ignore: a new voice.

She had been listening to the Bible in her own language. Not a sermon. Not a debate. Just stories about a God who created the world with a word. A God who sees. A God who loves. A God who speaks. And she said, "Today, I heard God speaking to me in my language."

The priest was disturbed. Then curious. Then silent. He went with her the next day. And he listened. What he heard—spoken in his heart language—began to unravel everything he thought he knew.

Weeks passed. He invited others. He opened his home. Eventually, he gave land for a tent to be pitched. And now, where there was once ritual and fear, there's a growing church built on truth.

This didn't happen through mass events or public campaigns. It happened through relationships. Through Scripture. Through discovery.

This is what God does when the Gospel arrives in a language people can understand—and when it's delivered in the context of love, not argument.

That moment of discovery sparked a change that continues today. An entire community is now walking in the light.



## FROM BRICKS TO BAPTISM

### INDIA

In 2024, a farming village in India, marked by long days of labor and generations of tradition, became the setting for an unexpected change.

One of our local movement catalysts, "Sam," met a woman named "Joy" while buying bricks at a factory. She looked tired and weighed down by cares she didn't voice, so in a quiet moment, Sam told her, "God can bring peace to your family."

Those words opened the door. Joy began to share about her struggles, and soon invited Sam to her home. Each week, the family gathered with him for a Discovery Bible Study. As they listened to Scripture and discussed it together, the stories of God's love began to replace the fear and pressure they had always known.

Before the year ended, Joy, her husband, and their two children decided to follow Jesus. They were baptized together, beginning a new way of life built on hope.

Today, Joy leads her own Discovery Bible Study and is introducing others in her village to the same message that transformed her family. What began with a simple conversation in a brick factory has grown into a witness that continues to spread.



## WHEN DISASTER SPARKED DISCIPLESHIP

### MYANMAR:

In Myanmar, following Jesus can cost you everything—your job, your home, even your life. Fear and surveillance are woven into everyday life, especially in rural regions where resistance to the Gospel runs deep.

But even in the shadows, the light is spreading.

Last quarter, in the midst of an earthquake and ongoing war, we launched a disaster aid initiative that didn't just bring physical relief—it brought the Word of God. Out of that effort, 23 new Discovery Bible Studies (DBS) began, offering people a safe way to hear Scripture and talk about what it means for their lives. This quarter, that number has continued to grow.

Some of these groups meet in homes, others in fields, always in secret. A group of seekers began listening to Scripture quietly—huddled around an audio player with the volume low but hearts open. The Word reached them in their language. And when it did, something shifted. They weren't just hearing information. They were discovering a Person.

What began as a whisper turned into obedience. Quiet faith became bold faith. One listener shared the stories with a neighbor. Then another. Soon, new DBS groups were multiplying in multiple villages.

And here's what's remarkable: they've never met a foreign missionary. No one flew in. No event was held. What reached them wasn't a strategy. It was the Spirit of God, the Word of God, and a tool you helped make possible.

This is the kind of ground-up growth only God can produce—and you've helped make room for it. In places we can't go, He still sends His Word. And because of you, they're hearing it.



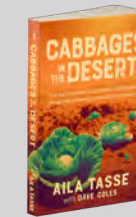

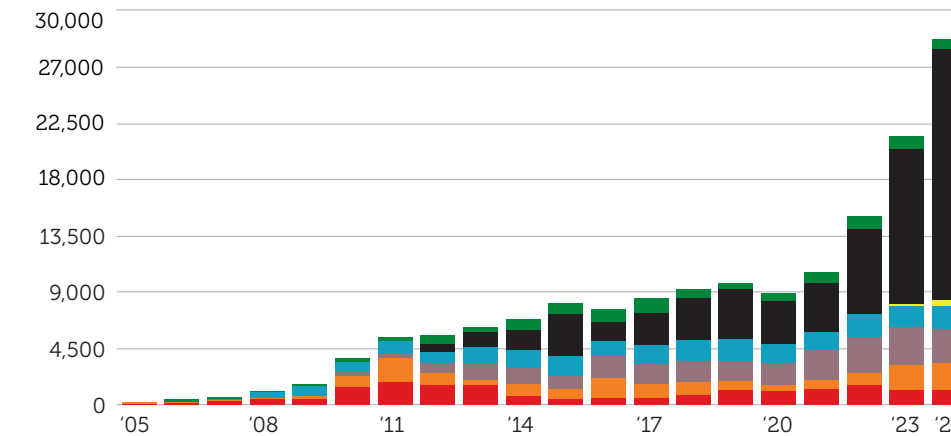
## REGIONAL BREAKDOWN OF 2,931,295 NEW CHRIST FOLLOWERS

Each icon represents approximately 2% or 58,626 new Christ followers



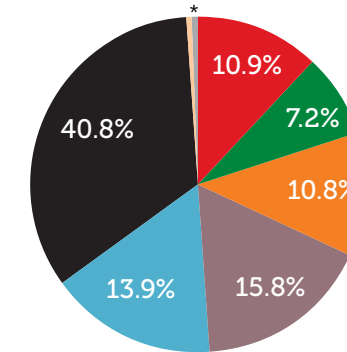

## TOTAL NEW CHURCHES

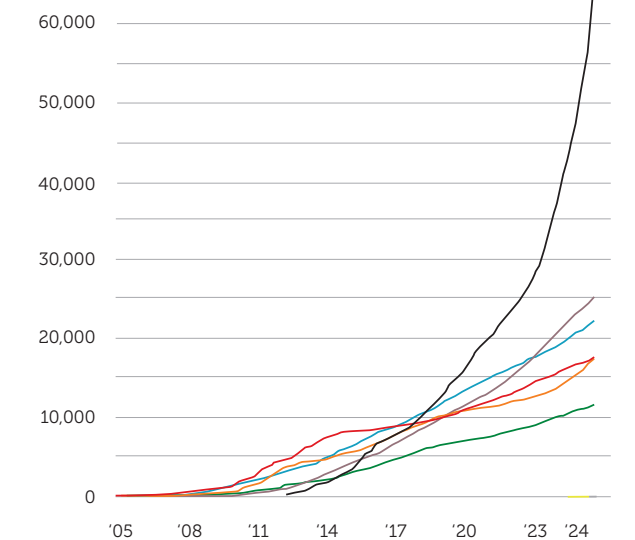
Approximate breakdown of 157,888 new churches since 2005 by region

# MEASURING WHAT MATTERS IN MOVEMENTS

When Jesus told the parable of the lost sheep, He said the shepherd left the ninety-nine to find the one that was missing. How did the shepherd know a sheep was gone? He counted — probably more than once.

Numbers matter when it comes to catalyzing movements of disciples making disciples and churches planting churches. Without tracking and evaluating, we won't:

- Know if what we're doing works
- Know how to course-correct
- Know where we should be headed

But numbers alone don't fulfill the Great Commission — relationships do. Proverbs 27:23 says, "Know well the condition of your flocks, and give attention to your herds."

When a group of African leaders studied this passage through Discovery Bible Study, they reflected on tending their family's herds in their youth. From those memories came a timeless list — a shepherd's checklist for caring for God's people.

- Are they alive?
- Are they gathered together?
- Are they well fed?
- Are they healthy?
- Are they growing?
- Are they safe?
- Are they reproducing?
- Are they living long?

These questions shape how we evaluate the health of the movements we serve.



## WHY AND HOW WE MEASURE MOVEMENTS

In the same way, we believe movements should be measured—not because numbers tell the whole story, but because they help us see whether the most important things are happening. It's not only about quantity; it's also about quality and health.

At New Generations, we use what we call the 3D-DMM process to help evaluate whether a Disciple Making Movement is growing in a healthy and sustainable direction:

- **DEEP**  
Are disciples healthy, obedient, and grounded in Scripture?
- **WIDE**  
Are new believers making disciples who make more disciples, rather than remaining "seedless grapes"?
- **LONG**  
Are the generations of disciples and churches continuing to replicate without us?

This is more than tracking growth — it's ensuring fruit that lasts and reproduces. Every quarter, our Shepherding Support Team partners with local leaders worldwide to strengthen movements and keep them aligned with the Great Commission. It's how we keep measuring what matters—and why we remain committed to movements that grow in ways that are strong, healthy, and enduring.

## DEEP, WIDE, AND LONG IN PRACTICE

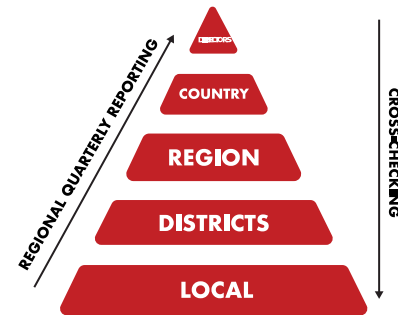
Once we know why measurement matters and how we measure, the next question is: how do we put this into practice?

Grounded in prayer, New Generations applies the 3D-DMM (3-Dimensional Disciple Making Movement) evaluation process every quarter, measuring the quality and health of disciples and churches (deep), the quantity of disciples, churches, and generations (wide), and the sustainability of replication without outside dependency (long).

To do this well, we gather both numbers and stories from every level where we serve — local, district, region, and country. Reports are carefully cross-checked by Shepherding Insight Coaches in each region, who provide insight and encouragement to the local pastoral leaders caring for disciples. This process gives regional leaders actionable intelligence, helping them identify strengths, address challenges, and more effectively shepherd the movements under their care.

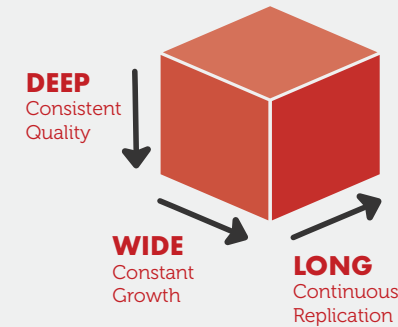
This approach ensures that we aren't just collecting data — we are strengthening movements. And when we track the right indicators consistently, we can see clearly whether disciples and churches are deep, wide, and long — movements that are healthy, multiplying, and lasting.

## 3D-DMM EVALUATION

New Generations is committed to a 3-dimensional Disciple Making Movements (DMM) evaluation process, one that ensures movements are:



### OUR INTENT

That every DMM practitioner pauses regularly to evaluate deeply by listening to God, and gains insights that shape their strategy.

### OUR GOAL

That every engagement becomes a Biblically healthy 3D movement that continues to replicate without us.

### OUR PROCESS

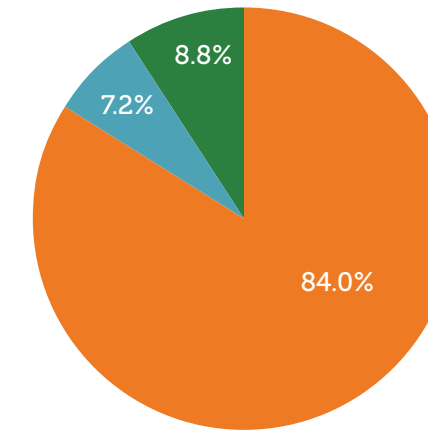
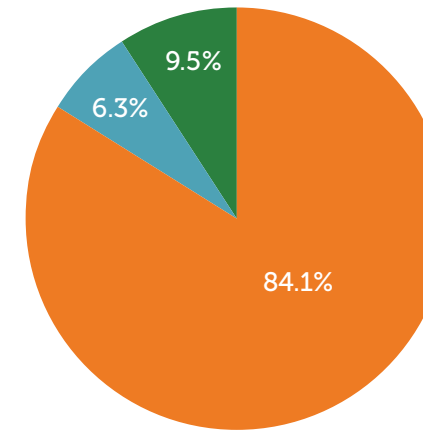

## LOCALLY LED

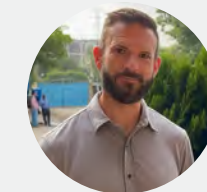
